It was published last month in the Journal of Women's Sports Medicine. Associate Professor. Jane S. Chung, M.D. (Scottish Rite) was the first author for the research.



EPOSNA 2024 Annual Meeting Recap

Early this month, there was a joint POSNA and EPOS meeting that was the largest academic pediatric orthopedic meeting in the world to have ever taken place. There were a record 1,359 submitted abstracts from institutions across the world.

Of those abstracts, UTSW/Scottish Rite for Children Faculty had 27 podiums, including collaborations on 12 different study group presentations. A robust portion of the scientific presentation included Assistant Professor, William Morris', M.D. (pictured bottom left), study on Developmental Dysplasia of the Hip, which was an award nominated paper.


Robotic total knee replacement improves outcomes but costs more

Total knee replacements performed with the help of a surgical robot have better outcomes on average than similar surgeries performed manually but can cost significantly more, a new study by UT Southwestern Medical Center researchers shows. Study leader, **Senthil Sambandam, M.D.**, Assistant Professor at UTSW Orthopaedic Surgery and Dallas VA faculty, talks about the studies findings.



Intersections of Fibrodysplasia Ossificans Progressiva and Traumatic Heterotopic Ossification

Heterotopic ossification (HO) is a debilitating pathology where ectopic bone develops in areas of soft tissue. HO can develop as a consequence of traumatic insult or as a result of dysregulated osteogenic signaling, as in the case of the orphan disease fibrodysplasia ossificans progressiva (FOP)

Pediatric femur fractures in children aged 5 to 11 years are typically classified as lengthstable versus length-unstable.
