


UCL injuries on the rise, from Little League to the major leagues | UT Southwestern MedBlog




Dr. Dickson gives lecture at the Barack Obama Male Leadership Academy

Multidisciplinary Studies from UTSW Orthopaedic Surgery and Radiology Featured in European Radiology and Skeletal Radiology



Risk of Revision Shoulder Arthroplasty After Anatomic and Reverse Total Shoulder Arthroplasty

Michael Khazzam, M.D. (Section Chief, Shoulder) had a study published in JAAOS in January. Many co-authors of this study were UT Southwestern individuals including current and former residents of our UT Southwestern Orthopaedic Surgery Residency Program. The objective of this study was survival rate of anatomic total shoulder arthroplasty (aTSA) and reverse TSA (rTSA) over a medium-term follow-up in a large population-base and to pinpoint potential risk factors for revision surgery.

Definition of Tweener: Consensus Among Experts in Treating Early-onset Scoliosis

This month, Brandon Ramo, M.D. and Jaysson Brooks, M.D. (Scottish Rite/UTSW) were among the many authors in this recent study published in the Journal of Pediatric Orthopaedics. The study uses the term "Tweener" as reference to early-onset scoliosis (EOS) patients whose age and development make them candidates for multiple surgical options. The purpose of this study was to establish expert consensus on a definition to formally characterize the Tweener population.




