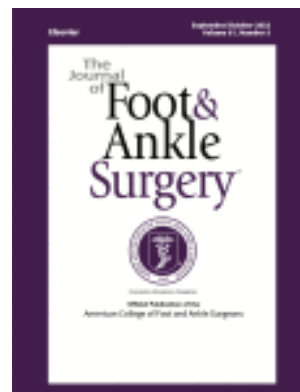


Mock surgeries show young women that there's room for them in the orthopedics field

New Employee Alert!

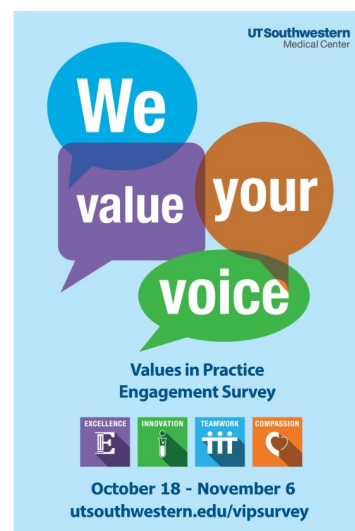

Happy 30th Anniversary, Metra!

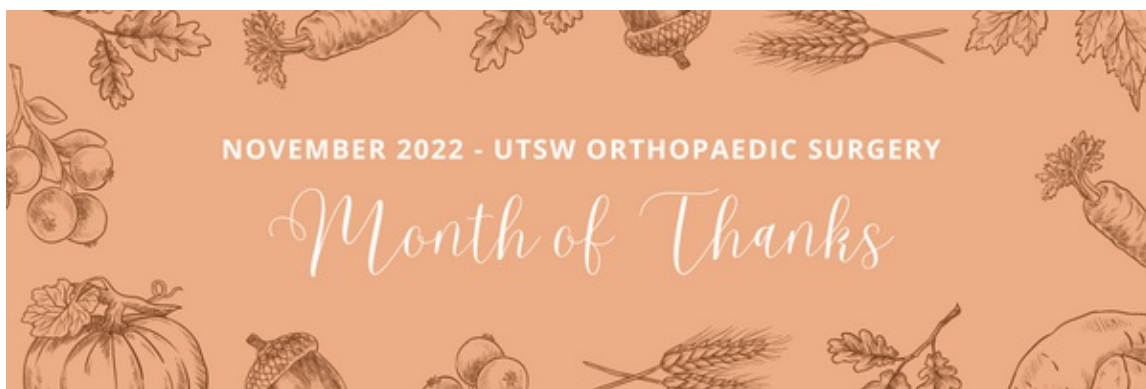
